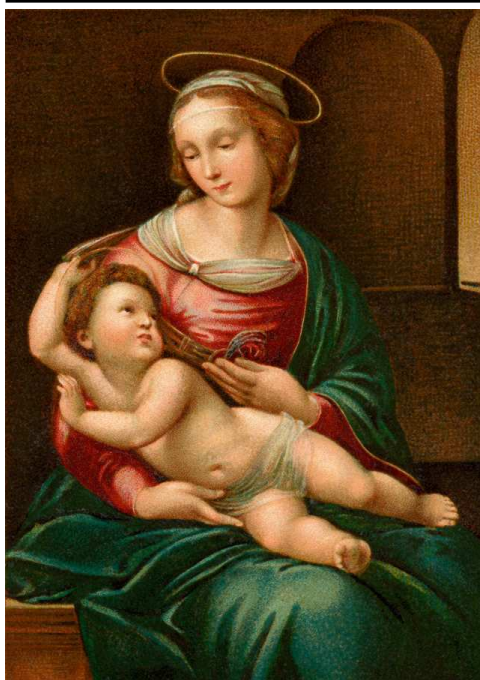

This.... 9.9% of Australians (including 365,000 children) live in poverty.

13,391 West Australians are homeless, 62% of these are aged 34 or younger. In October 2009 there were 70,500 West Australians unemployed and actively seeking work.
