Keeping the Memory Alive.... We were parishioners of the Regina Coeli Brentwood parish since 1966, prior to Saints John and Paul Willetton. During the Brentwood/Willetton association I worked on the Finance Committee as the representative of the Brentwood Parish. With the mushrooming population on the other side of Leach Highway, Willetton Parish became No 1 and our little church lost our resident priest.

For some years we were fortunate to have regular Masses supplied by many wonderful priests from Willetton and I helped fulfil the role of one of the Sacristans who functioned adequately with caring for the upkeep of the Church. At a later date we ceased our Willetton connection as we came under the Applecross Parish boundary.

There has been some water under the bridge since then and we have chosen to become "Willettoners". One of the main draw cards for us at Saints John and Paul is the Personal Advocacy group in which our daughter has belonged since its inception and is totally wrapped in it. She holds her advocate in the greatest esteem. We are so appreciative of Rossana and her tireless work in all areas of Saints John and Paul Parish.

Our Church has become a focal point in our lives and although there are times when we attend another parish for convenience, we are always happy to get back to our regular surrounds and familiar faces. Mass times are easy to comply with and the devotional atmosphere makes prayer concentration more possible. (I must confess that is a problem I have!!) I do like the 9.00am Mass most weekdays and I have enjoyed attending many of the adult education courses held in the Parish through which I have made many friends.

Keeping the Memory Alive.... I, with my husband Harry, were members of the Brentwood/Willetton family since its beginning. In 1961 we joined the Brentwood Regina Coeli Parish. What a wonderful experience that was, one big happy family, a little chapel built by the people for the people.

Fr Richard Doyle became our Parish Priest (1976-1994) and during the mid 70s he was asked to build a new church centre in Willetton as the areas of Bateman, Bull Creek and Willetton were expanding very rapidly. In 1980 the hall and presbytery were built and the Brentwood presbytery was sold. On December 22 1985, Archbishop Foley blessed and opened Saints John and Paul Church.

During the 1980s the parish purchased and named Foley House in Willetton to help house newly arrived refugees. Many other groups were started, apart from the Parish Council. The Sisters of St Joseph of the Apparition minister in many ways. Solace, the Craft Circle, John Paul Care, Growing Vine and many others still exist today.

In April 1982 I was asked by our then Assistant Priest, Fr Kevin Cronin, at the request of another parishioner, to set up some activities for the senior members. So with a small group of generous volunteers we started the Growing Vine. I'm proud to say that it continues today. I was blessed to share to many happy times with both the helpers and the members for 20 years. Needless to say, they are like family to me.

The Willetton Parish took over running Orana Catholic School. Prior to this, it was run by the Riverton Parish. Fr Jim Corcoran, Fr Steve Casey and many other wonderful priests have contributed greatly to the parish up to the present day. I think we have been blessed. May the parish continue to grow and be cherished by us all. *Joan Grove*
